And because the damage caused by burn injuries and oral cancer continues despite the epidemic, we also organized prevention activities online.

In 2021, Sunshine Foundation will celebrate its 40th anniversary. Overview of Services in 2020

Core services of Sunshine - Enhancing the autonomy and social participation of our clients, elevating their quality of life



Physical rehabilitation

- Rehabilitation services: A total of 378 clients received physical rehabilitation services at Sunshine's Rehabilitation Centers, for a total of 5,983 sessions. In addition, 475 clients benefited from 1,044 home rehabilitation visits.
- 250 clients received home nursing visits.
- Assistive devices services: A total of 4,496 pressure garments were made for 990 clients.

Psychosocial rehabilitation

- Sunshine social workers worked with a total of 2,318 clients and 821 of them were new clients.
- Psychological counseling:
 - Individual counseling: 126 people / 750 sessions
 - Group counseling: 19 sessions / 143 attendances
- Image enhancement services: 70 people
- Social participation services:
 - Development projects: 10 projects / 174 attendances
 - Supportive projects: 155 projects / 2,094 attendances

Vocational services

- Sunshine provided employment services to 32 clients. Sunshine successfully referred 17 clients to regular jobs, and 10 of them maintained stable employment.
- Sunshine organized vocational workshops attended 133 times to help clients prepare their return to work.

Care and independent living training

Sunshine Half-Way House provided short-term housing services to 27 people with major burns in need of intensive physical, psychological and vocational rehabilitation.

Financial aid

Sunshine provides financial aid that covers the expenses of medical treatment, rehabilitation, pressure garments and other assistive devices, daily living and transportation. In 2020, 664 people received financial aid subsidies, totaling NT\$10,157,687.

Reduce the incidence of betel nut-related oral cancer cases

- Raised awareness about the dangers of betel nut, organizing a total of 512 educational activities attended by 62,220 people.
- Partnership with the Taiwan Alliance for Areca Nut Control and Oral Cancer Prevention.

Promote Face Equality

- Organized 554 social education activities on the topic of Face Equality that were attended by 67,524 people.
- A total of 22 city and county governments pledged to support Face Equality.

Enhance public awareness about burn prevention and first aid

- Organized 74 social education activities on burn prevention and first aid, attended by 8,629 people.
- Interactive fire prevention exhibition held in partnership with the Taipei City Fire Safety Museum was visited 6,357 times.

Sunshine Carwash Centers

- Sunshine Carwash Centers employed a total of 53 people with disabilities and set up trusts for 47 employees, to assist with their career planning and retirement preparation.

Sunshine Gas Station

- Sunshine Gas Station employed 51 people with disabilities and set up trusts for 93 employees, to assist with their career planning and retirement preparation.

Sunvis

- Sunvis provided 16,767 fitness training sessions targeting special needs groups (elderly, people with disabilities) and employed 15 employees with disabilities.

Major Events in 2020

February

Pingtung and Kinmen county governments pledged to support Face Equality.

April

Sunshine was entrusted by the Taipei City government with operating the fitness center for people with disabilities.

July

- Penghu county government pledged to support Face Equality.
- The 2020 Face Equality Taipei City Marathon is held, attracting 5,030 participants.

September

- Sunshine organizes an exhibition of paintings and drawings made by children with a facial difference.
- Sunshine organizes professional online training on the topic of pressure garment fabrication for physical therapists and seamstresses in Nicaragua and Honduras.

October

The work and services of Sunshine's Taoyuan-Hsinchu Service Center is recognized with an award from Taoyuan City government.

November

- Sunshine Gas Station and Sunshine Car Wash received for a fifth consecutive year the Golden Wingspan Award for the promotion of employment for people with disabilities.
- In partnership with the Taiwan Alliance for Areca Nut Control and Oral Cancer Prevention, Sunshine organized its annual Oral Cancer Prevention Survey with 22 city/county governments.

December

- Sunshine's Yunlin-Chiayi Service Center celebrates its 10th anniversary.
- Sunshine was entrusted by the Taoyuan City government with operating the fitness center for people with disabilities.
- Sunshine organized its annual scholarship event, with 519 children with facial difference receiving awards and recognition.
